Operations

Sample Company, Inc. manufactures durable and comfortable footwear tailored to the needs of specific occupational and recreational activities, from farming to hunting and hiking. The company's brands include Sample, XXXX, XXXX, and XXXX. The Sample Shoes brand is distributed in over 100 countries, including over 6,000 U.S. retail locations serving both consumer and industrial customers.

The company operates three domestic manufacturing facilities in Sample, Minnesota; Potosi, Missouri and Danville, Kentucky. All company plants have earned certifications for ISO 9001 international quality standards. The company also owns and operates the ZZZ Company, which supplies premium leather for shoes, apparel, furniture and other applications.

Within the U.S. market, this network includes about 430 Sample Stores (of which about 165 are company owned), plus an industrial sales operation employing 180 mobile shoe trucks. Approximately 15 percent of overall revenues are generated from sales outside the United States. Around 75 percent of revenues are attributable to its U.S. made lines; the remaining sales come from less-expensive styles made under license by Chinese contractors.

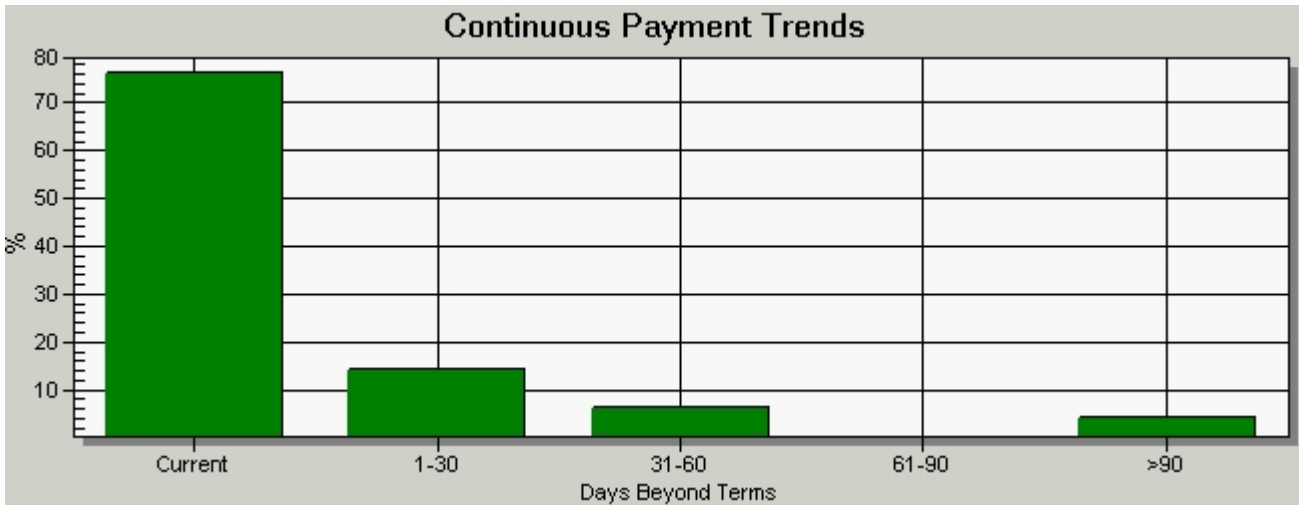

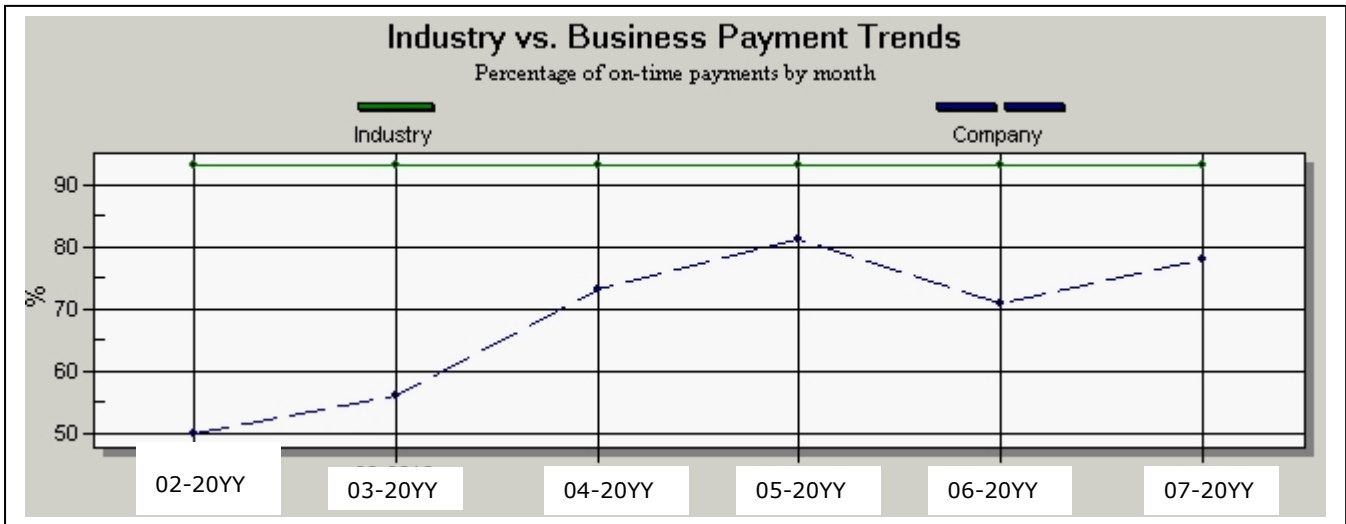

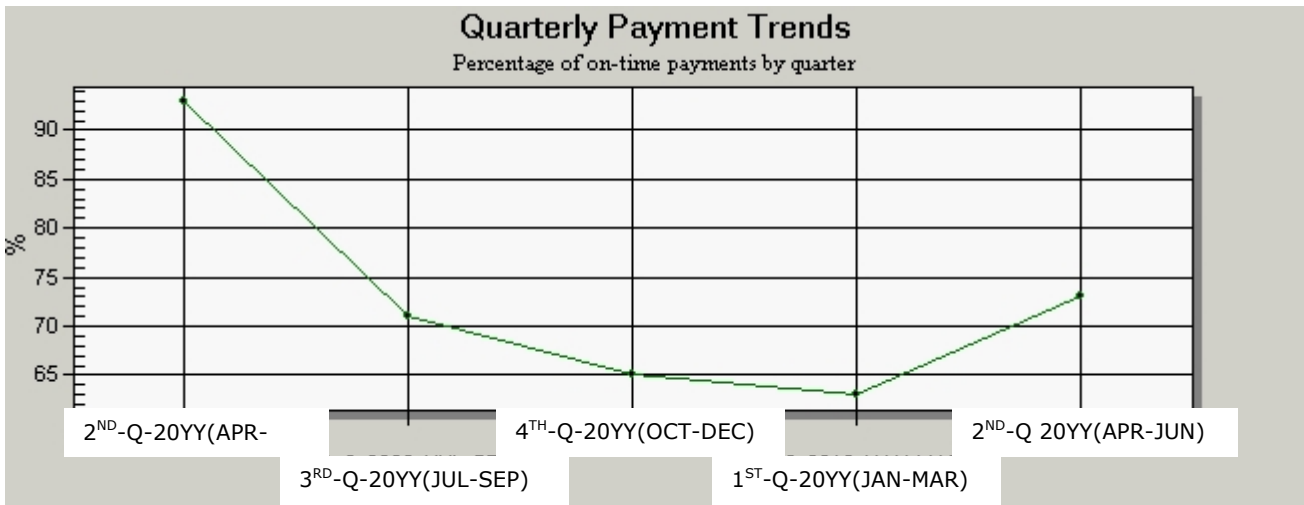

The doors are staying open a little while longer at the Sample shoe plant in Danville, but the company says it is only a temporary reprieve.

It was announced in November that the plant would begin phased layoffs and shut down for good last month. However, company spokesmanXXX Engel said that date has been pushed back to MM. DD.

When the original announcement was made, Engel said the operations were being moved to the company's Potosi, Mo., plant because of larger capacity and capability for expansion there.

In the meantime, Engel said the timeline was pushed back due to an unexpected increase in demand for work boots.

About 200 people were employed at the plant at the time the closing was announced. Engel said there are currently 110 people still working at Sample, while some of the manufacturing operations already have been absorbed by the Potosi plant.

Sample sold the building to a Lebanon-based company on MM. DD with an agreement to lease back the building on a temporary basis.

Last week, the state announced that Sample employees were approved for federal Trade Adjustment Assistance.

Some workers previously laid off by Sample Co. in Danville and Lexington Hd-Leader Co. may apply for additional federal assistance, the state announced Wednesday.

State officials said in a news release that the U.S. Department of Labor has certified both companies as "adversely affected employers" under the federal Trade Act, which provides assistance to workers of companies hurt by import competition.

The move covers workers laid off on or after MM. DD, 20YY, at the Hd-Leader and MM. DD, 20YY, at the Sample Co. The latter announced in mid-November it planned to close its plant that employed 206. The Hd-Leader has had a series of layoffs since 20YY that have included the outsourcing of certain job functions overseas.

The state said laid-off workers who have run out of unemployment benefits might be eligible for retroactive benefits. Workers also may apply for financial assistance, and help with training, job searches and relocation. This assistance will be available through MM DD, 20YY, for Hd-Leader workers and MM DD, 20YY, for Sample Co. workers. Applications may be filed at offices including the Central Kentucky Job Centers at 1055 Industry Road in Lexington and XXXEast Broadway in Danville.
